Amount

One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of **\$2000**.

Eligibility

- 1. The applicant must be enrolled at Georgia Institute of Technology.
- 2. The applicant must at least be entering their third year of undergraduate study at minimum or any year of their graduate study and must have a declared major of Civil Engineering for the semester the scholarship is awarded (Spring 2024).
- 3. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only once.
- 4. The applicant must submit a completed application and an official copy of their college transcript. Resumes may also be included but are not required.
