The Babs Abubakari Scholarship is available to those students pursuing undergraduate or graduate degrees at the Georgia Institute of Technology and seeking a career in civil engineering, civil engineering technology, or other transportation or construction related fields.

Amount

One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of **\$2000**.

Eligibility

1. The applicant must be enrolled at Georgia Institute of Technology.
2. The applicant must at least be entering their third year of undergraduate study at minimum or any year of their graduate study and must have a declared major of Civil Engineering for the semester the scholarship is awarded (Spring 2024).
3. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only once.
4. The applicant must submit a completed application and an official copy of their college transcript. Resumes may also be included but are not required.
