



2026 Jim McGee Memorial Scholarship General Academic Scholarship Information

The scholarships under this program are available for those students seeking a career in civil engineering, civil engineering technology, or other transportation or construction related fields.

Amount

The maximum total amount awarded will be **\$10,000**.

Up to four scholarships may be awarded. The selected recipients will be determined based on the quality of applications received and the review committee's recommendations. The maximum amount awarded to any single recipient will be **\$4000**. The minimum amount awarded to any single recipient will be **\$2000**.

Eligibility

1. The applicant must be enrolled in an ABET accredited program at a school in Georgia.
2. The applicant must be an undergraduate who will be entering either the third or fourth year of a four-year program or the second year of a two-year program by the fall semester of the submission year. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student for the fall semester of the submission year (Fall 2026).
3. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only once.
4. The applicant must submit a completed application and a copy of their college transcript. Resumes may also be included but are not required.
